ACCMP operates as a **continental hub for professional training, research, and institutional capacity building**, serving:

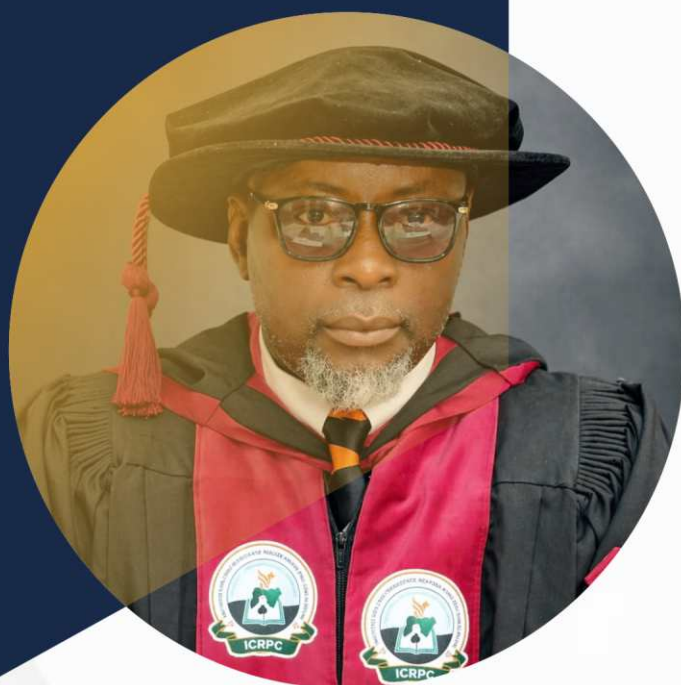

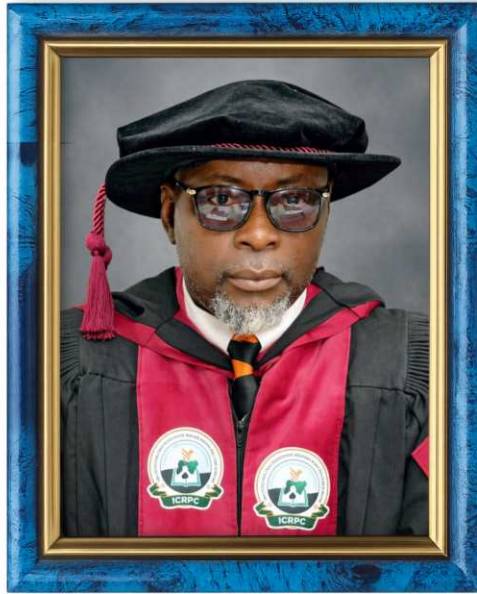

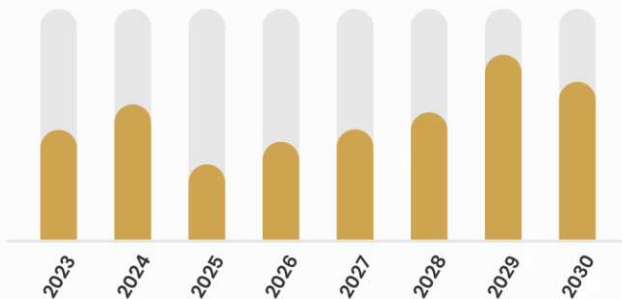
